

## Dear colleagues:

As you know, the XXXI NATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY CONGRESS, will be held in our city, CEUTA (Spain), from the 11th to 15 October 2017.

The aim of this letter is to explain you the way you should follow to make the arrangements for your travel to Ceuta:

# ¿How to travel to Ceuta?

#### By sea:

If you wish to get Ceuta (Spain) by sea, crossing the strait of Gibraltar, you can choose among three shipping companies that operate from Algeciras (Spain), with almost 20 daily travels, crossing the strait in nearly one hour with high-speed catamarans, and with capacity for passengers and cars.

The shipping companies with daily links between Ceuta and Algeciras are: Trasmediterránea Balearia

However, we have arranged special rates with Balearia, in order you can travel cheaper.

# By air:

FRS Iberia.

If you wish to get Ceuta by air, you should choose your flight from your original place to nearest airports: Gibraltar (United Kingdom) or Tánger (Morocco).

From the Gibraltar airport you can connect the spanish city of Algeciras by bus (it takes 30 minutes), and from this city you can choose among three shipping companies that operate from its port.

From the Tánger airport you can connect with the taxi services, that it will take you up to the international border with Ceuta in nearly one hour.

By the way, if this is your choice, please do not forget to deal the travel price with the taxi driver in advance (very advisable to haggle over the price)

If this option would be chosen by more than 20 participants, the transfer between Tanger Airport-Ceuta-Tanger Airport, could be managed with a mini bus shuttle.



## By land: Train

You can get Ceuta by train in two different ways:

- By AVE (High-Speed train) to the Spanish cities of Malaga or Seville, and from those cities take a bus to the Spanish city of Algeciras.
- By train from Madrid to Algeciras (it takes nearly 5 hours)

#### By land: private car:

You can drive up to the city of Algeciras

Notice.- For the participants who travel with private cars, the organization has arranged a parking in Algeciras with cheaper prices.

## For those participants who travel from outside Spain:

We advice you to fly from you original place to the spanish cities of Madrid, Seville or Malaga, or directly fly to Gibraltar (United Kingdom) or Tánger (Morocco).

The participants who will travel to the cities of Tánger or Chaouen (Morocco), must hold a valid passport.

However, in order to solve any doubt about your transport, your travel or your accommodation in Ceuta, we have managed the professional services of our partner travel agency, VIAJES TRUJILLO; we give you the telephone contact of the person who is in charge of the organization for the travel of this Congress:
